Health Science Change of Major Process –

All students seeking a change of major to Health Science must have a current overall GPA greater than or equal to 2.0 and completed the following courses with a grade of C or above prior to submitting a completed change of major packet for Health Science:

- STAT 1 Introduction to Statistics

If the student has successfully completed the pre-major course requirements, the student must provide completed copies of the attached forms, copies of all college transcript, and additional supplemental material required as part of the process. ***A student's change of major application will be rejected if the student fails to properly complete the required forms and submit all required information.***

1. Complete the Sacramento State Declaration of Major & Deletion of Major forms.
2. Complete the Health Science Change of Major Student Information form.
3. Complete the Health Science Change of Major Progress form.
4. Attach copies of all college transcripts, including CSUS. (Unofficial transcripts are acceptable)
5. Secure all required material with a heavy duty paperclip.
6. Submit the completed forms and supplemental material to the Health Science Program Coordinator, Solano Hall 3002.
